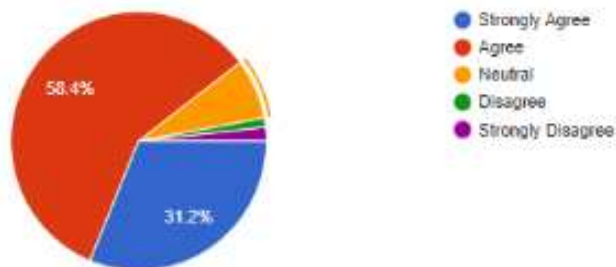
The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the Shri Shankaracharya Mahavidyalaya Junwani, Bhilai (C.G.) in association with the various departments in the college, collects students' feedback on syllabus annually. A specified sample from the students in proportionate to the strength of each batch is taken for the study. A well designed and structured questionnaire is used to collect the responses. The objective of the feedback is to analyze the importance and relevance of the syllabus, and how far it has catered to the needs of the academic community. It also tries to evaluate whether the modules in the syllabus are properly sequenced, and the allocation of the classes are in proportionate to the time stipulated. The availability of the syllabus oriented books and e-resources in the library, the functional nature and activity orientation of the syllabus, the competitiveness of the syllabus with the latest advancements in the subject, the syllabus orientation of the internal evaluation system in the college, the values and ethics inculcated by it, and the career orientation of the syllabus are the various aspects, which the study has focused to delve deep with.

The report tries to give a clear picture regarding the feedback system of the college through a systematic analysis of the responses of the students on each academic year. The responses on all the ten questions in the questionnaire are analyzed separately.

1. The syllabus is career oriented.

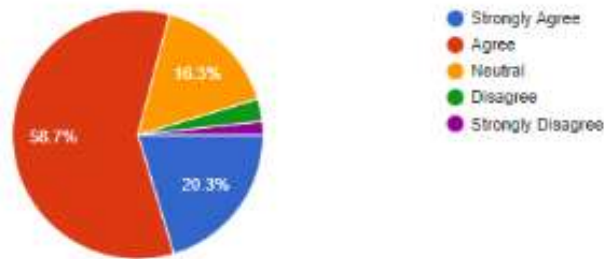

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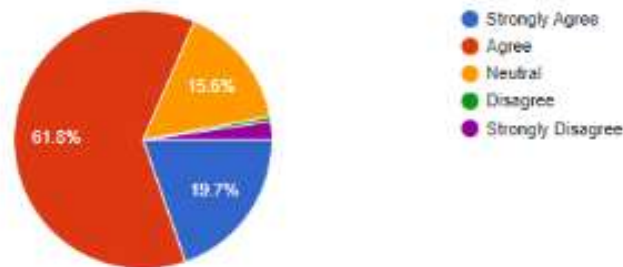

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2. The quantum of the syllabus is in proportion with the time frame.



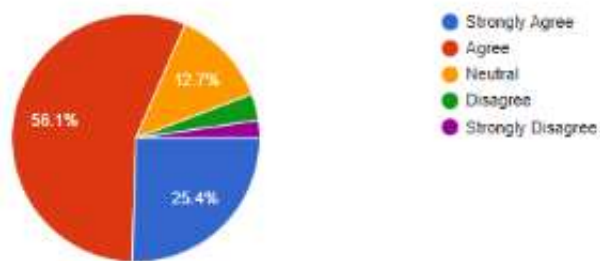

4. The curriculum is designed to enhance employability



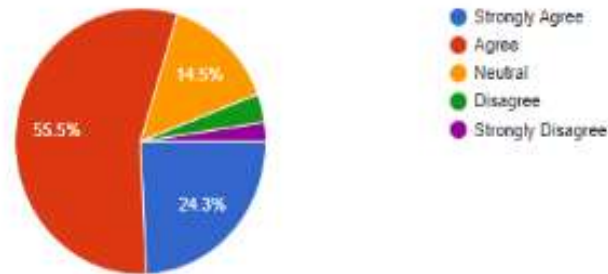

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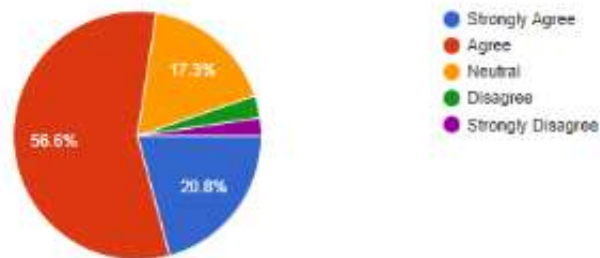
4% rate that they are completely unsatisfied by the way in which the assessment is conducted.

5. There is sufficient availability of books and reading materials prescribed in syllabus



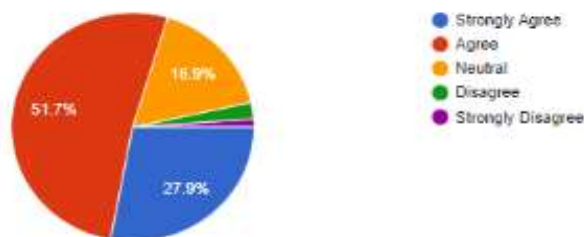

7. The course inspired me to pursue Higher studies / Research work.

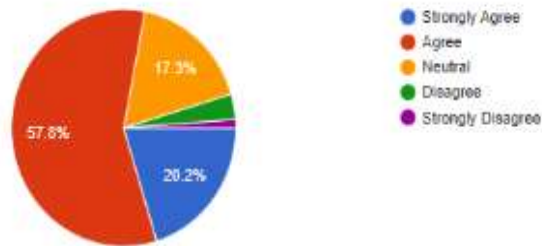


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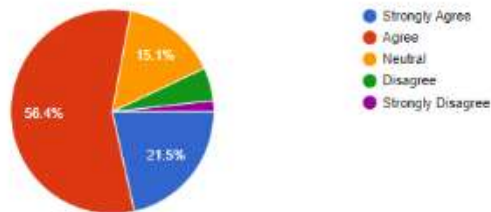

8. The syllabus enable to improve ability to formulate/ analyse/ solve



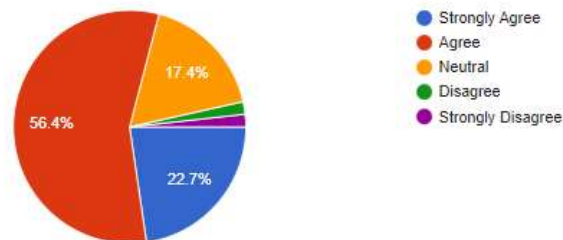
88.0 % of the respondents respond positively to this question. According to them, the syllabus enable to improve ability to formulate/ analyse/ solve. 17.3% are neutral,

- Encourage participatory learning

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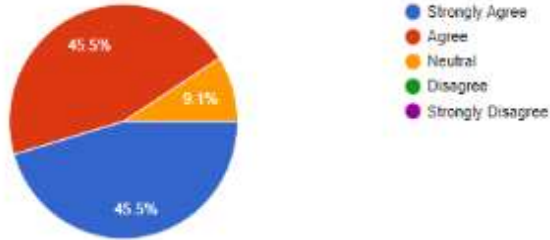


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TEACHERS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

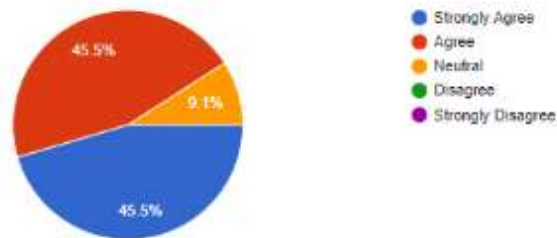

2. The course has good balance between theory and practical's

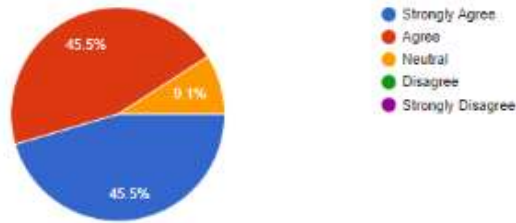


91.0% of the teachers suggested that the course has good balance between theory and practical's while 9.1% of teachers are neutral

3. The syllabus of the particular subject increases the knowledge and perspective in the subject area

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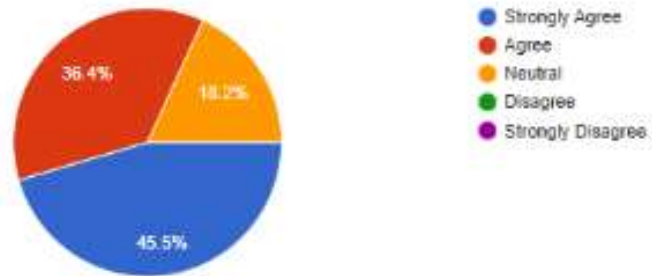

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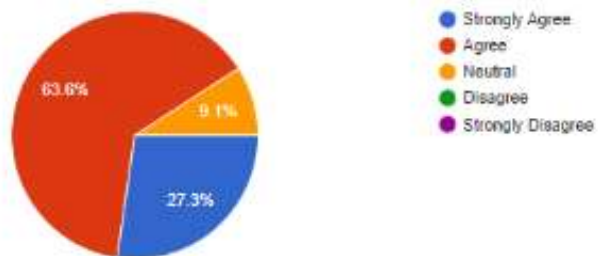
4. Curriculum ensure special awareness among the students

5. The curriculum is sufficient to cover the course outcomes

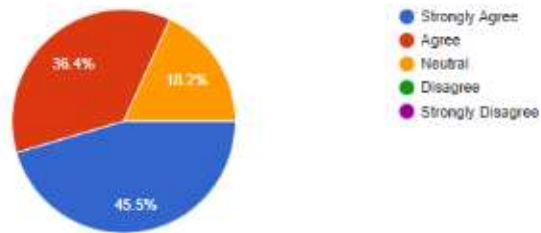


90.9% of the teachers suggested that The curriculum is sufficient to cover the course outcomes while 9.1% of teachers are neutral

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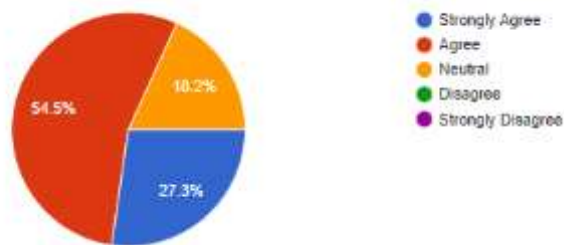
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6. The curriculum ensures student participation in learning process



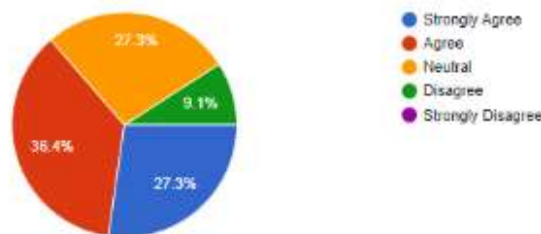
81.9 % of the teachers suggested that The curriculum ensures student participation in learning process while 18.2% of teachers are neutral

8. The syllabus is sufficient to bridge the gap between industry standards/ current global scenarios and academics

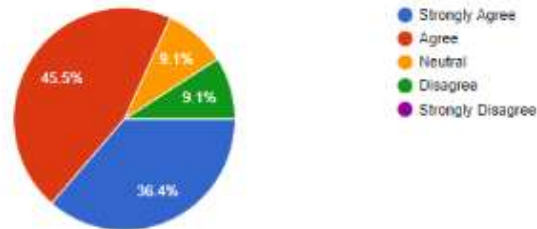


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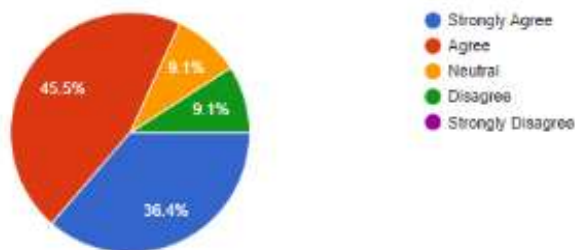

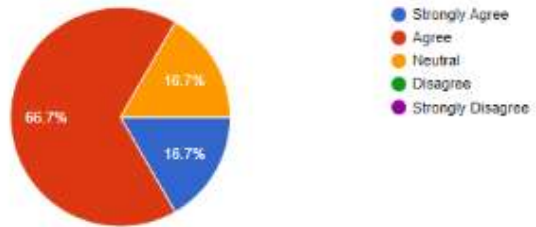
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EMPLOYER FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

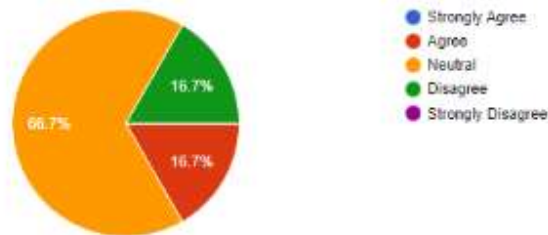

3. The employee is practical in solving issues related to work



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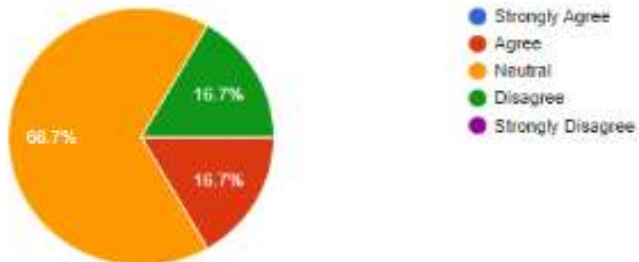
50 % responded agree to this question that employee is practical in solving issues related to work while 50 % of employer are neutral

5. The employee is more analytical in assessing situations

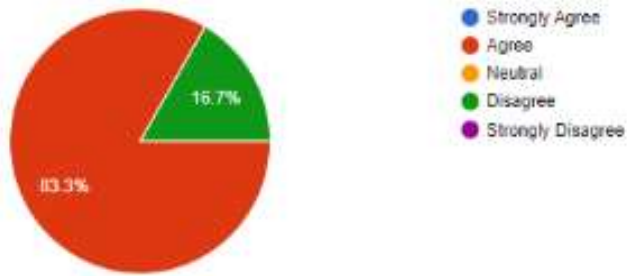


16.7 % responded agree to this question that employee is more analytical in assessing situations while 66.7 % of employer are neutral and 16.7% of employer disagree

6. Employee is self-learner and has incorporated methods while working:

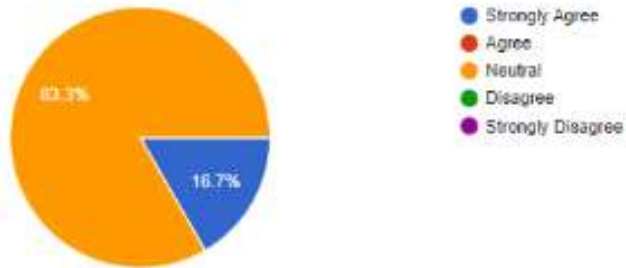
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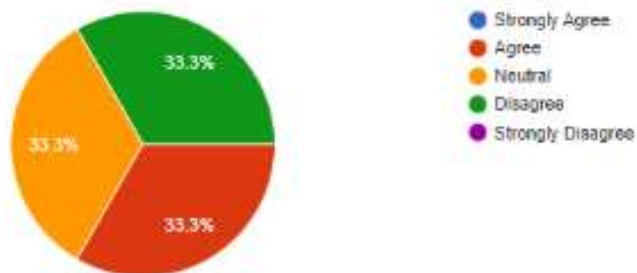
83.3 % responded agree to this question that Employee is self-learner and has incorporated methods while working while 16.7 % of employer are neutral and 16.7% of employer disagree

8. Employee has effective communication Skills:

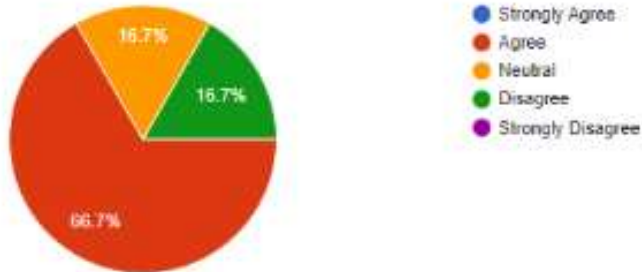


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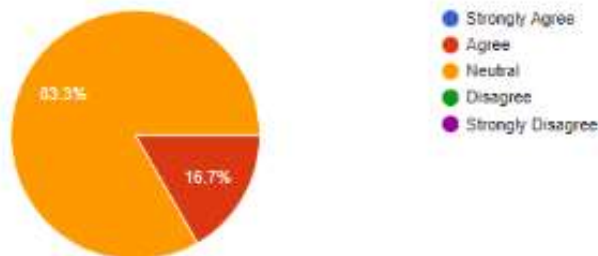
33.3 % responded agree to this question that Employee has effective communication skills while 33.3 % of employer are neutral and 33.3% are disagree

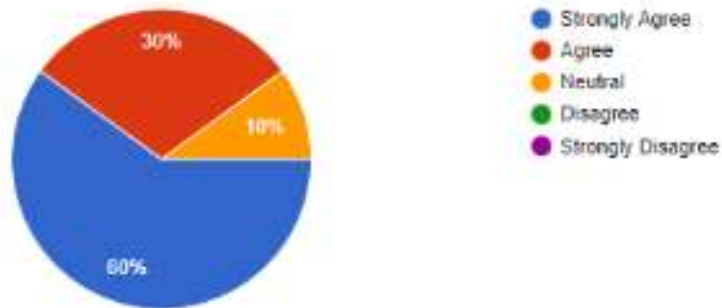

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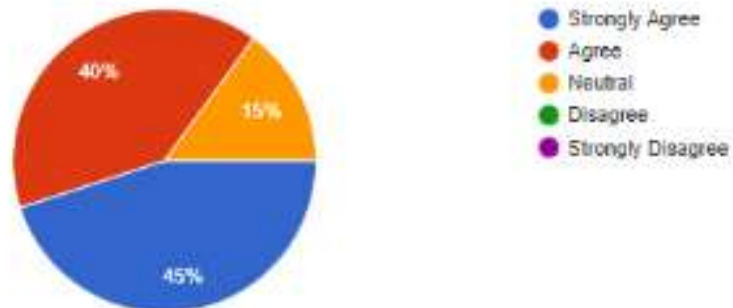
ALUMNI FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

2. Course content is interesting:

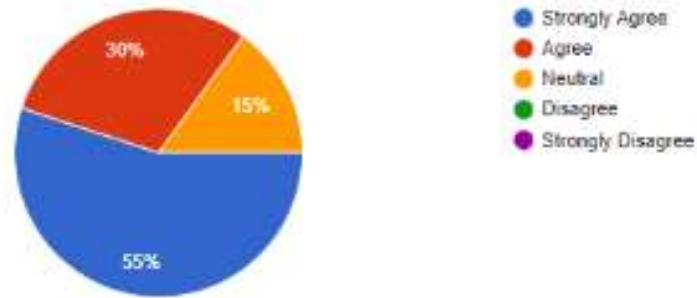


85.0 % responded positively to this question that Course content is interesting while 15 % of employer are neutral

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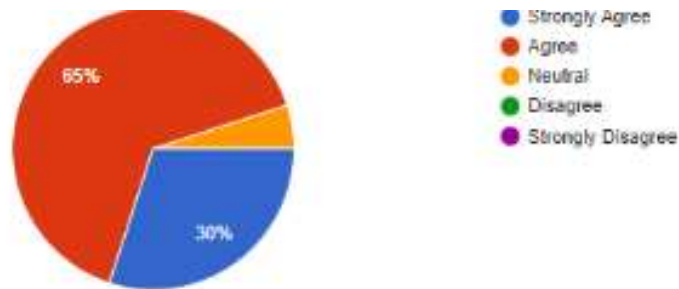

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3. The course curriculum had fulfilled my expectations:

4. Awareness is provided on career option in the college:

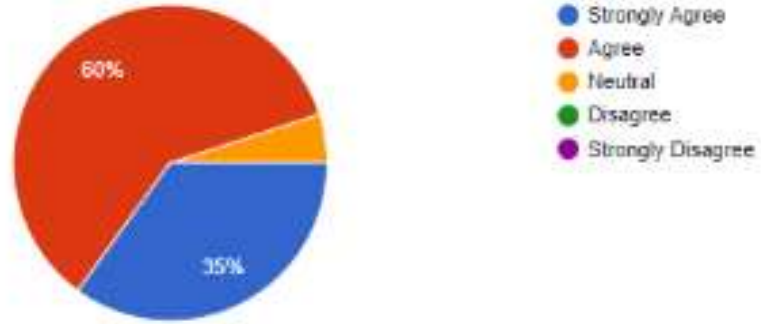


95.0 % responded positively to this question that Awareness is provided on career option in the college while 5 % of employer are neutral

5. Academic flexibility in terms of course combination is offered in the college:

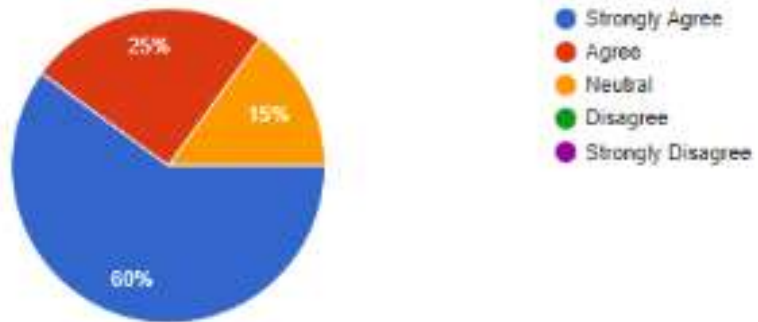
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95.0 % responded positively to this question that Academic flexibility in terms of course combination is offered in the college while 5 % of employer are neutral

7. The curriculum helped my career enhancement:

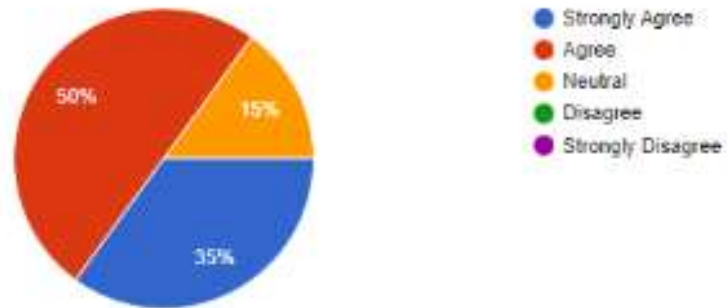
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95.0 % responded positively to this question that curriculum helped my career enhancement while 5 % of Alumni are neutral

8. Awareness on issues relevant to professional ethics, gender, human values, environment and the sustainability as provided effective through syllabi:

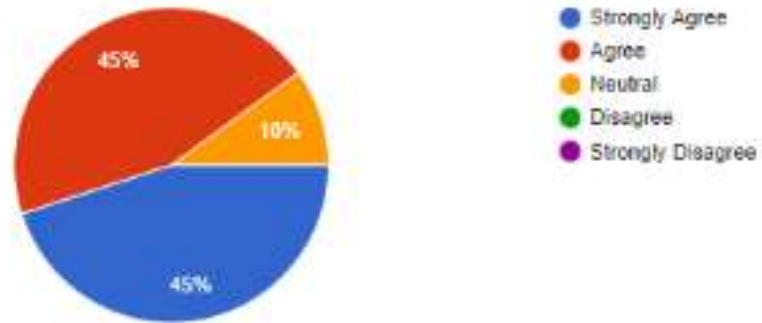

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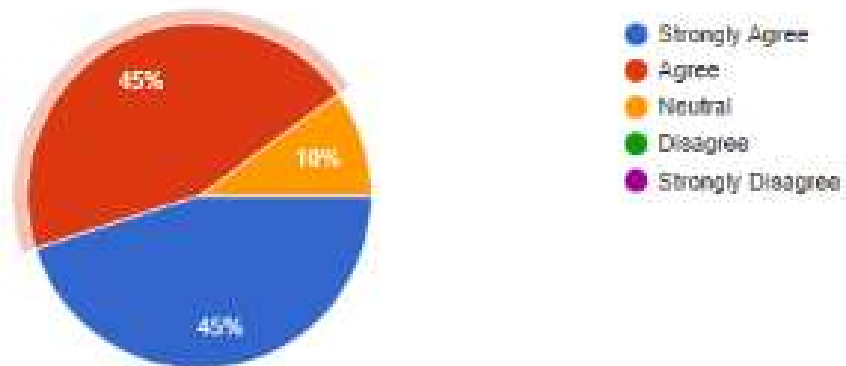

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9. Curriculum that i have chosen helped me to enrich my life skill:
