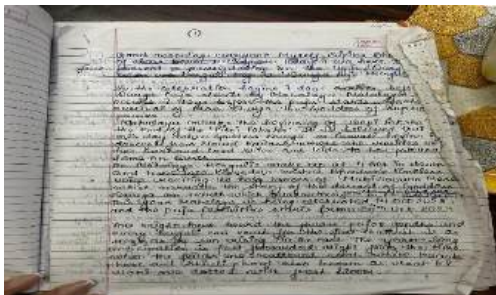

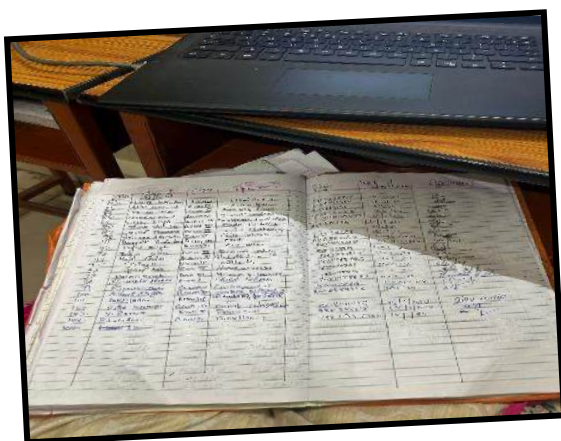

Overview

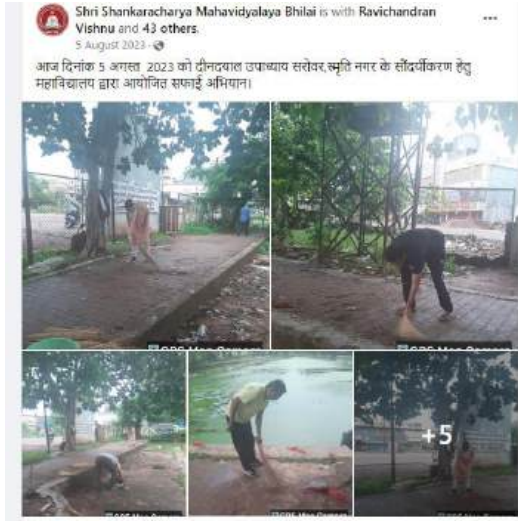

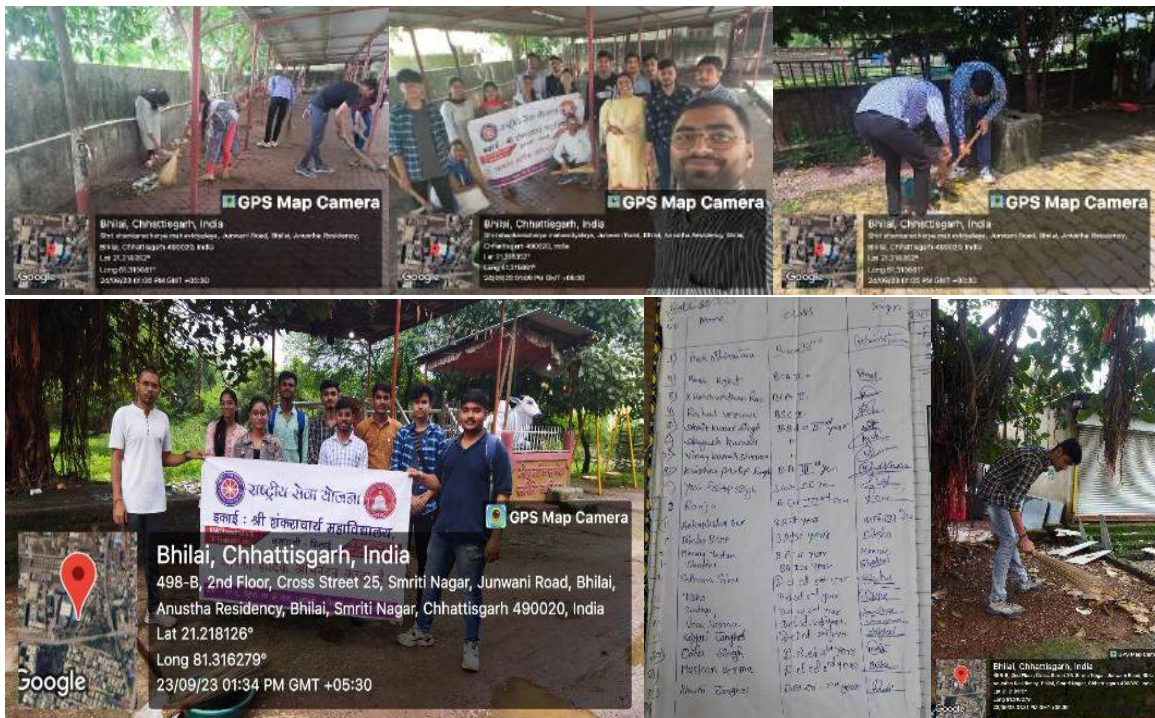

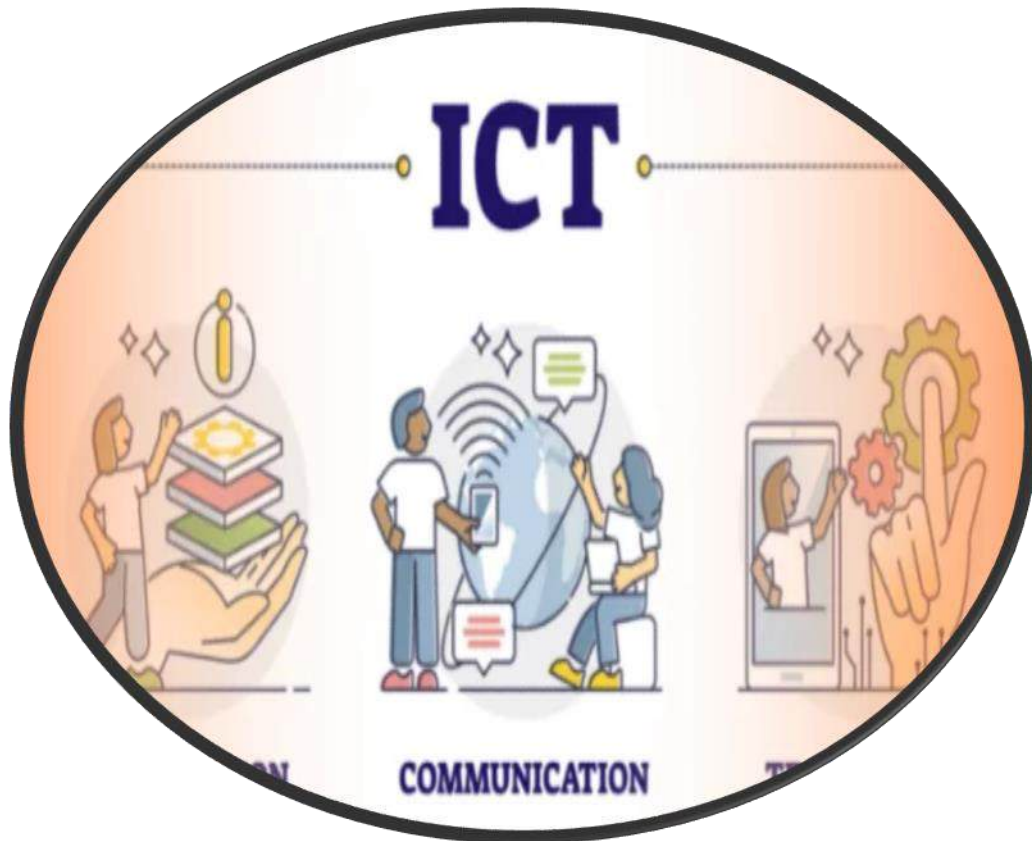

Day-6

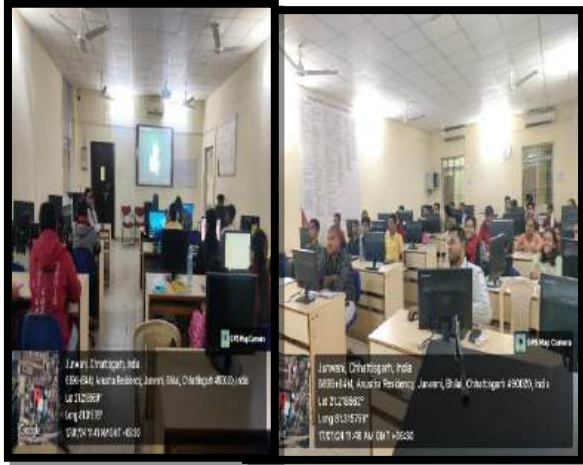
