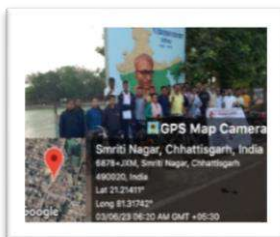

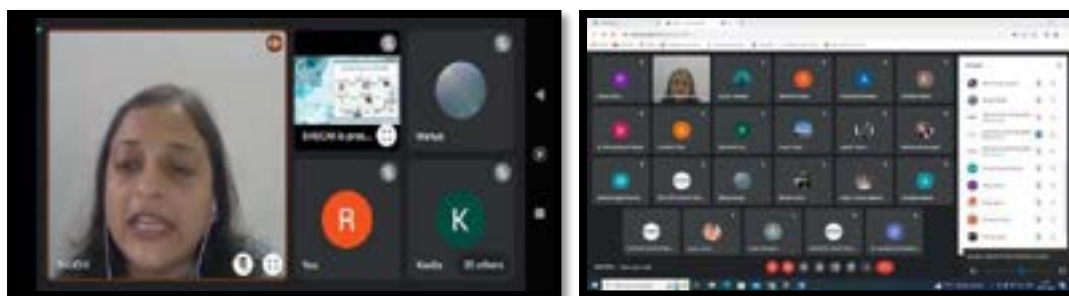
Event Report:

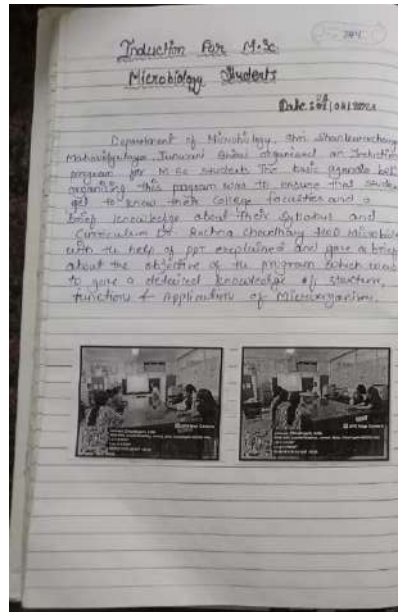

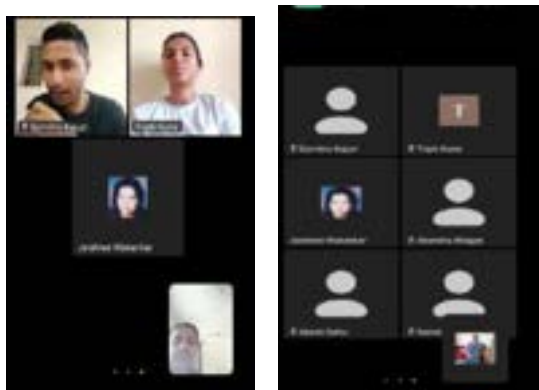
Alumni meet was organized by the Faculty of Arts, Shri Shankaracharya Mahavidyalaya.

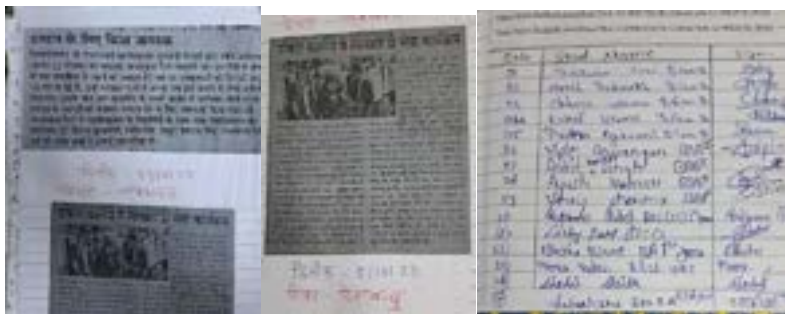

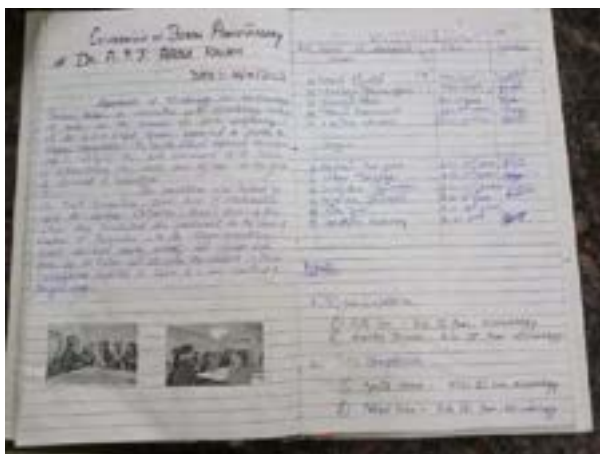

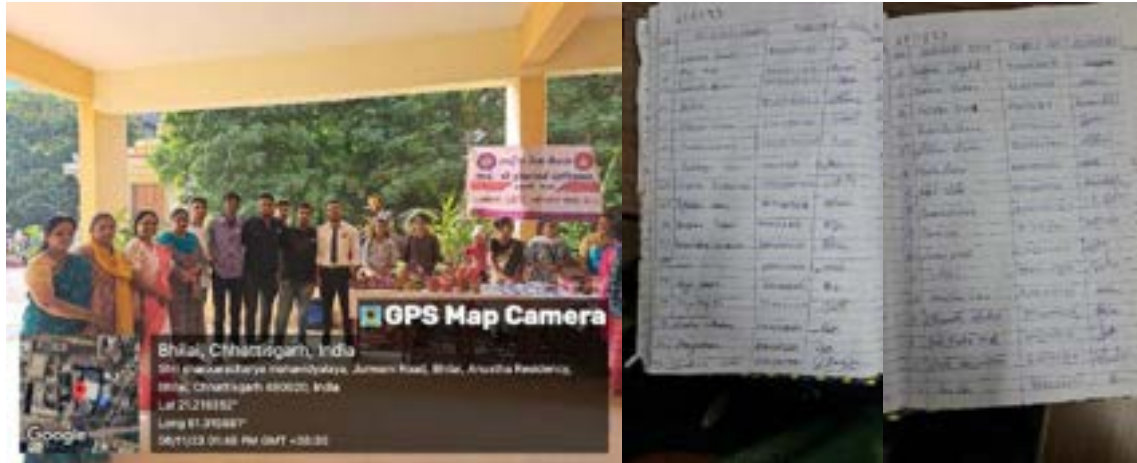

A 15-day certificate training program organized at Sri Sankaracharya Mahavidyalaya under the joint aegis of the Department of Botany and Chemistry from 1 December 2023 to 15 December 2023 on the topic - “Green Synthesis of Nanoparticles”, which concluded by awarding certificates to the students. This event was organized under the leadership of Ms. Varsha Yadav (Head of Department of Botany) and Mrs. Padma Rani Verma (Head of Department of Chemistry). In this training program, students were made aware about the concept of nanotechnology, approaches to nanoparticle synthesis and green synthesis of nanoparticles. In this program, the Principal of the college Dr. Archana Jha, Dean Academic of the college Dr. J Durga Prasad Rao, Head of the Department of Microbiology Dr. Rachna Chaudhary and the Head of the Department of Zoology Dr. Sonia Bajaj and other professors were specially present.

Outcome: In this 15-day event, students learned what a nanoparticle is, their synthesis from plants and how nanoparticles can be beneficially used in our lives and their future possibilities were explained in detail. It develops therapeutic nanosized materials for biomedical and pharmaceutical applications. Chemical methods for the synthesis of nanoparticles require toxic chemicals, organic solvents and stabilizers as reducing agents, as a result, it causes toxicity in the environment. Therefore, except for their use in a variety of diagnostic and biomedical fields, a clean, reliable, biocompatible and eco-friendly green synthesis approach should be used for nanoparticle synthesis. In this way, plant-mediated synthesis of nanoparticles is considered more suitable. Biological synthesis of nanoparticles is being carried out by leaves, seeds, roots of various plants, bacteria, fungi, seaweeds and microalgae. Biosynthesized nanomaterials are effectively controlling various endemic diseases with minimal adverse effects. Plants contain abundant natural compounds such as alkaloids, flavonoids, saponins, steroids, tannins and other nutritional compounds.
